

Councilman N. E. Revis introduced the following ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 20

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILSONVILLE, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

That that certain ordinance passed by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Wilsonville, Alabama, on the 6th day of April, 1934, at a special meeting be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

That "SECTION 1" thereof be and the same is hereby deleted therefrom and the following words and figures are adopted in lieu thereof:

SECTION 1. As used in this ordinance the term "gasoline" shall include, gasoline, naphtha, and other liquid and motor fuels used in combustion engines, except for diesel fuel, provided that nothing contained in this ordinance shall apply to the products commonly known as kerosene oil, distillate oil, gas oil, crude oil or diesel fuel. The word "person" means and includes every person, corporation, copartnership, company, agency or association. The term "distributor" shall include any person who shall engage in the selling or delivery of gasoline, as herein defined, in the corporate limits of the Town of Wilsonville, Alabama, or the police jurisdiction thereof, by wholesale, in domestic trade, but shall not apply to any transaction by such distributor in interstate commerce.

Said ordinance was read at length and thereupon Councilman N. E. Revis moved that unanimous consent of the members be given for the immediate consideration of and action upon said ordinance, which motion was seconded by Councilman W. W. Foster. Said motion for unanimous consent was submitted to a vote of the Council and said vote was as follows:

AYES: 3

NAYS: 2

Thereupon, the mayor declared said motion carried and unanimous consent given for the immediate consideration of and action upon said ordinance.

Councilman N. E. Revis moved that said ordinance be adopted, which motion was seconded by Councilman W. W. Foster. Said motion for the adoption of said ordinance was submitted to a vote of the Council and said vote resulted as follows:

AYES: 3

NAYS: 2

The Mayor then declared said motion carried and said ordinance adopted.
