

SECTION EIGHT. If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held by any Court to be invalid or illegal, it shall not affect the validity of other legal provisions.

SECTION NINE. If any license herein levied is by the Court declared unconstitutional, it shall in no way affect the legality or constitutionality of any other license thereunder.

SECTION TEN. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION ELEVEN. The Town of Wilsonville, Alabama, having a population of less than 2,000 inhabitants, as shown by the last federal census, the Town Council elects to give notice of the passage of this ordinance by posting notices at three public places within the corporate limits of said Town, one of which shall be posted in front of the Mayor's Office or at the United States Post Office.

Said ordinance was read at length, and thereupon Councilman V. J. Fulmer moved that unanimous consent of the Mayor and Council be given for the immediate consideration of and action upon said Ordinance, which motion was seconded by Councilman G. W. Rayfield. Said motion for unanimous consent was submitted to a vote of the Mayor and Council and said vote resulted as follows:

REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILSONVILLE,  
ALABAMA, HELD ON THE 6th DAY OF JUNE, 1955

A regular meeting of the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Wilsonville, Alabama, was held in the regular place for holding meetings of said Council on June 6, 1955, at 7:30 o'clock p.m. and there were present at said meeting the Mayor, S. S. McEwen, and the following Councilmen: G. K. Baker, V. J. Fulmer, D. F. Belton, G. W. Rayfield, the same constituting a quorum.

Councilman V. J. Fulmer introduced the following Ordinance:

GRADE ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND ESTABLISHING THE GRADE OF THE FOLLOWING STREETS AND PARTS OF STREETS IN THE TOWN OF WILSONVILLE, ALABAMA, VIZ:  
McGOWAN ROAD FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE EASTERLY LINE OF ALABAMA HIGHWAY 25 AND EXTENDING IN A NORTHEASTERLY DIRECTION 2614.0 FEET TO POINT OF ENDING; HILL STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTH LINE OF McGOWAN ROAD AND EXTENDING NORTH 670 FEET, MORE OR LESS, TO THE NORTH LINE OF THE MAMIE HILL PROPERTY; POPE STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE WEST LINE OF ALABAMA HIGHWAY 25 AND EXTENDING IN A NORTHWESTERLY DIRECTION 677.6 FEET TO THE SOUTH MARGIN OF WELDON STREET; CHURCH STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE WEST LINE OF POPE STREET AND EXTENDING NORTHEASTERLY 287.5 FEET TO THE SOUTH MARGIN OF MAIN STREET; SCHOOL STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE EAST LINE OF NIVENS STREET AND EXTENDING IN A NORTHEASTERLY DIRECTION 573.7 FEET TO THE SOUTH MARGIN OF MAIN STREET; JACKSON STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTH LINE OF ALABAMA HIGHWAY 25 AND EXTENDING IN A NORTHWESTERLY DIRECTION 676 FEET TO THE POINT OF ENDING, BEING THE SOUTH LINE OF A COUNTY ROAD; WELDON STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH A POINT ON THE PROJECTION OF THE EAST MARGIN OF POPE STREET AND EXTENDING IN A SOUTHWESTERLY DIRECTION 314.7 FEET TO THE POINT OF ENDING; NIVENS STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTH MARGIN OF WELDON STREET AND EXTENDING IN A NORTHERLY AND WESTERLY DIRECTION 1194 FEET; AND HEBB ROAD, BEGINNING AT A POINT APPROXIMATELY 40 FEET SOUTHEAST OF THE SOUTH RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF SOUTHERN RAILROAD GRADE CROSSING IN WILSONVILLE AND EXTENDING SOUTHEASTERLY A DISTANCE OF 1692 FEET TO THE POINT OF ENDING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILSONVILLE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

That the grades on the following streets and parts of streets in the Town of Wilsonville, Alabama, viz: McGowan Road from its intersection with the easterly line of Alabama Highway 25 and extending in a northeasterly direction 2614.0 feet to point of ending; Hill Street from its intersection with

the north line of McGowan Road and extending north 670 feet, more or less, to the north line of the Mamie Hill property; Pope Street from its intersection with the west line of Alabama Highway 25 and extending in a northwesterly direction 677.6 feet to the south margin of Weldon Street; Church Street from its intersection with the west line of Pope Street and extending northeasterly 287.5 feet to the south margin of Main Street; School Street from its intersection with the east line of Nivens Street and extending in a northeasterly direction 573.7 feet to the south margin of Main Street; Jackson Street from its intersection with the north line of Alabama Highway 25 and extending in a northwesterly direction 676 feet to the point of ending, being the south line of a County Road; Weldon Street from its intersection with a point on the projection of the east margin of Pope Street and extending in a southwesterly direction 314.7 feet to the point of ending; Nivens Street from its intersection with the north margin of Weldon Street and extending in a northerly & westerly direction 1194 feet; and Hebb Road, beginning at a point approximately 40 feet southeast of the south right of way line of Southern Railroad Grade Crossing in Wilsonville and extending southeasterly a distance of 1672 feet to the point of ending; be and the same are hereby fixed and established as shown on the Profile Sheets lettered 1 and 2, heretofore exhibited to the Town Council and now on file in the office of the Town Clerk.

Said Ordinance was read at length, and thereupon Councilman D. F. Bolton, G. W. Rayfield moved that unanimous consent of the Mayor and Council be given for the immediate consideration of and action upon said Ordinance, which motion was seconded by Councilman G. W. Rayfield. IMPROVEMENT ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS ON MCGOWAN ROAD FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE EASTERLY LINE OF ALABAMA HIGHWAY 25 AND EXTENDING IN A NORTHEASTERLY DIRECTION 2614.0 FEET TO POINT OF ENDING; HILL STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTH LINE OF MCGOWAN ROAD AND EXTENDING NORTH 670 FEET, MORE OR LESS, TO THE NORTH LINE OF THE MAMIE HILL PROPERTY; POPE STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE WEST LINE OF ALABAMA HIGHWAY 25 AND EXTENDING IN A NORTH-WESTERLY DIRECTION 677.6 FEET TO THE SOUTH MARGIN OF WELDON STREET; CHURCH STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE WEST LINE OF POPE STREET AND EXTENDING NORTHEASTERLY 287.5 FEET TO THE SOUTH MARGIN OF MAIN STREET; SCHOOL STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE EAST LINE OF NIVENS STREET AND EXTENDING IN A NORTHEASTERLY DIRECTION 573.7 FEET TO THE SOUTH MARGIN OF MAIN STREET; JACKSON STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTH LINE OF ALABAMA HIGHWAY 25 AND EXTENDING IN A NORTHWESTERLY DIRECTION 676 FEET TO THE POINT OF ENDING, BEING THE SOUTH LINE OF A COUNTY ROAD; WELDON STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH A POINT ON THE PROJECTION OF THE EAST MARGIN OF POPE STREET AND EXTENDING IN A SOUTHWESTERLY DIRECTION 314.7 FEET TO THE POINT OF ENDING; NIVENS STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTH MARGIN OF WELDON STREET AND EXTENDING IN A NORTHERLY AND WESTERLY DIRECTION 1194 FEET; AND HEBB ROAD, BEGINNING AT A POINT APPROXIMATELY 40 FEET SOUTHEAST OF THE SOUTH RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF SOUTHERN RAILROAD GRADE CROSSING IN WILSONVILLE AND EXTENDING SOUTHEASTERLY A DISTANCE OF 1672 FEET TO THE POINT OF ENDING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILSONVILLE, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

That McGowan Road from its intersection with the easterly line of Alabama Highway 25 and extending in a northeasterly direction 2614.0 feet to point of ending, shall be constructed 18 feet wide
