

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND
TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILSONVILLE, ALABAMA

A call meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Wilsonville, Alabama, was held in the office of the Town Clerk in the Town Hall in Wilsonville, Alabama, the regular place for holding meetings of said Council, on the afternoon of September 6, 1961, at 2:00 o'clock p.m. and there were present at said meeting, R. G. Stephenson, Mayor and the following Councilmen: Lee Reinhardt, S. S. McEwen, Jimmie Morris, B. E. Cunningham, Winston Baker.

Councilman B. E. Cunningham introduced the following Ordinance:

GRADE ORDINANCE NO. 4-B

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND ESTABLISHING THE GRADE OF THE FOLLOWING STREETS AND PARTS OF STREETS IN THE TOWN OF WILSONVILLE, ALABAMA, VIZ: KENNEDY AVENUE FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE CENTER LINE OF HEBB STREET AND EXTENDING EASTERLY 735 FEET TO A POINT IN THE INTERSECTION OF BRELAND AVENUE; BRELAND AVENUE FROM THE CENTER LINE OF BROTHERS AVENUE AND EXTENDING IN A NORTHERLY DIRECTION OF 1300 FEET TO THE CENTER OF KENNEDY AVENUE; SPEARMAN STREET, BEGINNING AT THE POINT OF INTERSECTION 10 FEET TO THE EAST OF THE CENTER LINE OF ALABAMA HIGHWAY NO. 25 AND EXTENDING IN AN EASTERLY DIRECTION WITH THE MEANDERINGS OF SPEARMAN STREET A DISTANCE OF 1500 FEET TO A POINT; BROTHERS AVENUE, FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE CENTER LINE OF HEBB ROAD AND EXTENDING IN AN EASTERLY DIRECTION 2255 FEET TO THE POINT OF ENDING; THAT CERTAIN STREET LEADING FROM ALABAMA HIGHWAY NO. 25 BY THE WATER TANK TO CUNNINGHAM SUBDIVISION, BEGIN 10 FEET EAST OF THE CENTER LINE OF ALABAMA HIGHWAY NO. 25 AND EXTENDING EASTERLY ALONG THE MEANDERINGS OF SAID STREET 540 FEET TO THE EXISTING PAVEMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILSONVILLE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

That the grades of the following streets and parts of streets in the Town of Wilsonville, Alabama, viz: Kennedy Avenue from its intersection with the center line of Hebb Street and extending easterly 735 feet to a point in the intersection of Breland Avenue; Breland Avenue from the center line of Brothers Avenue and extending in a northerly direction 1300 feet to the center of Kennedy Avenue; Spearman Street, beginning at the point of intersection 10 feet to the east of the center line of Alabama Highway No. 25 and extending in an easterly direction with the meanderings of Spearman Street a distance of 1500 feet to a point; Brothers Avenue, from its intersection with the center line of Hebb Road and extending in an easterly direction 2255 feet to the point of ending; that certain street leading from Alabama Highway No. 25 by the water tank to Cunningham Subdivision, begin 10 feet east of the center line of Alabama Highway No. 25 and extending easterly along the meanderings of said street 540 feet to the existing pavement; and are hereby fixed and established as shown on the Profile Sheets of Paving Plans containing Pages 1 through 8, heretofore exhibited to the Town Council and now on file in the office of the Town Clerk.

Said Ordinance was read at length, and thereupon Councilman Winston Baker moved that unanimous consent of the Mayor and Council be given for the immediate consideration of, and action upon said Ordinance, which motion was seconded by Lee Reinhardt. Said motion for unanimous consent was submitted to a vote of the Mayor and Council and said vote resulted as follows:

Thereupon the Mayor in open council declared said motion carried and unanimous consent given for the immediate consideration of, and action upon said ordinance.

Councilman Jimmie Morris moved that said Ordinance be adopted, which motion was seconded by Winston Baker. Said motion for the adoption of said ordinance was submitted to a vote of the Mayor and Council and said vote resulted as follows:
