

IMPROVEMENT ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS ON KENNEDY AVENUE FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE CENTER LINE OF HEBB STREET AND EXTENDING EASTERLY 735 FEET TO A POINT IN THE INTERSECTION OF BRELAND AVENUE; BRELAND AVENUE FROM THE CENTER LINE OF BROTHERS AVENUE AND EXTENDING IN A NORTHERLY DIRECTION 1300 FEET TO THE CENTER OF KENNEDY AVENUE; SPEARMAN STREET, BEGINNING AT THE POINT OF INTERSECTION 10 FEET TO THE EAST OF THE CENTER LINE OF ALABAMA HIGHWAY NO. 25 AND EXTENDING IN AN EASTERLY DIRECTION WITH THE MEANDERINGS OF SPEARMAN STREET A DISTANCE OF 1500 FEET TO A POINT; BROTHERS AVENUE, FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE CENTER LINE OF HEBB ROAD AND EXTENDING IN AN EASTERLY DIRECTION 2255 FEET TO THE POINT OF ENDING; THAT CERTAIN STREET LEADING FROM ALABAMA HIGHWAY NO. 25 BY THE WATER TANK TO CUNNINGHAM SUBDIVISION, BEGIN 10 FEET EAST OF THE CENTER LINE OF ALABAMA HIGHWAY NO. 25 AND EXTENDING EASTERLY ALONG THE MEANDERINGS OF SAID STREET 540 FEET TO THE EXISTING PAVEMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILSONVILLE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. That a prime coat of RC-3 tar 19 feet wide shall be placed on the base course heretofore constructed, after which a double bituminous surface treatment 18 feet wide shall be placed on the following described streets and avenues, all in accordance with plans and specifications heretofore filed in the office of the Town Clerk of Wilsonville, Alabama, said streets and avenues being described as follows:

Kennedy Avenue from its intersection with the center line of Hebb Street and extending easterly 735 feet to a point in the intersection of Breland Avenue;

Breland Avenue from the center line of Brothers Avenue and extending in a northerly direction 1300 feet to the center of Kennedy Avenue;

Spearman Street, beginning at the point of intersection 10 feet to the east of the center line of Alabama Highway No. 25 and extending in an easterly direction with the meanderings of Spearman Street a distance of 1500 feet to a point;

Brothers Avenue, from its intersection with the center line of Hebb Road and extending in an easterly direction 2255 feet to the point of ending;

That certain street leading from Alabama Highway No. 25 by the water tank to Cunningham Subdivision, begin 10 feet east of the center line of Alabama Highway No. 25 and extending easterly along the meanderings of said street 540 feet to the existing pavement.

SECTION TWO. That said improvements shall be made in accordance with the established grades on file in the office of the Town Clerk for the said portions of said streets, avenues and alleys, and according to full details, drawings, plans, specifications and surveys of said work and estimates which have been prepared by the Town Engineer, exhibited to the Town Council, and are not now on file in the office of the Town Clerk in the City Hall at Wilsonville, Alabama, where property owners who may be affected by said improvements may see and examine the same.

SECTION THREE. That the cost of constructing said improvements shall be assessed against the property abutting on the portions of the streets, avenues and alleys so improved, provided:

(A) That the cost of improving any intersections or any part thereof shall be assessed against the lots or parcels of land abutting on each of the streets, avenues, alleys so intersecting for a half block in each direction therefrom, provided that, for the purpose of computing assessments, no block shall be considered as extending more than 1000 feet from any intersection so improved.

(B) That no assessment shall exceed the cost of such improvements or the increased value of the property assessed by reason of the special benefits derived from such improvements.

SECTION FOUR. That the detailed estimates of the cost of such improvements on file in the office of the Town Clerk aggregate \$8450.00 and that the Town Council of Wilsonville will meet on the 2nd day of October, 1961, in the Town Hall in Wilsonville, Alabama, at 7:00 o'clock p.m. to hear any objections remonstrances or protests that may be made against said improvements, the manner of making the same or the character of materials to be used.

SECTION FIVE. That this ordinance be published for two successive weeks in a newspaper published in the Town of Columbiana, Alabama, and that the Town Clerk be and is hereby directed to have the same so published; and that the Town Clerk also be and is hereby directed to send a copy of this ordinance by registered mail, postage prepaid, to the persons last assessing for Town taxation the property which may be assessed for said improvements, at their last known addresses, said notices to be mailed not less than ten (10) days before the meeting of the Town Council provided for in the next preceding section hereof.

Said ordinance was read at length, and thereupon Councilman S. S. McEwen moved that unanimous consent of the Mayor and Council be given for the immediate consideration of, and action upon said ordinance, which motion was seconded by Councilman Lee Reinhardt. Said motion for unanimous consent was submitted to a vote of the Mayor and Council and said vote resulted as follows:

Thereupon, the Mayor in open council declared said motion carried and unanimous consent given for the immediate consideration of and action upon said ordinance.

CONFIRMATORY IMPROVEMENT ORDINANCE NO. 7

WHEREAS, in and by an ordinance entitled "Improvement Ordinance No. 6" duly adopted by the Town Council of the Town of Wilsonville, Alabama, at a special meeting thereof held on September 6, 1961, the paving of certain streets in said town were determined upon, ordered and authorized;

WHEREAS, said Improvement Ordinance No. 6 was duly published once a week for two consecutive weeks in the Shelby County Reporter, a newspaper published in the City of Columbiana, Alabama, and having a general circulation in the town of Wilsonville, Alabama, said publications appearing in the issues of said paper of September , 1961, and September , 1961;

WHEREAS, in and by said ordinance and the notices thereof, it was ordered and provided that the Council of the Town of Wilsonville, Alabama, meet at 7:00 o'clock p.m. on the 2nd day of October, 1961, for the purpose of hearing, and that at such time it would hear any objections or remonstrances that may be made to said improvements, the manner of making the same or the character of material or
