Said motion for unanimous consent was submitted to a vote of the Council and said vote was as follows:

Councilman Reed Smith moved that said ordinance be adopted, which motion was seconded by Councilman W. W. Foster. Said motion for the adoption of said ordinance was submitted to a vote of the Council and said vote resulted as follows:

The Mayor then declared said motion carried and said ordinance adopted.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 25

Councilman Reed Smith introduced the following Ordinance:

WHEREAS, it is to the interest of the citizens of the Town of Wilsonville, Alabama, that a Recreation Board be formed for said Town;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILSONVILLE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

That the Recreation Board of the Town of Wilsonville be and the same is hereby created.

Be it further ordained that said board shall consist of five (5) members selected by the municipal governing body of the Town of Wilsonville from residents of said Town who have recognized interest in recreational activities. Members of said board first appointed shall be as follows:

- 1 member for the term of one year
- 1 member for the term of two years
- 1 member for the term of three years
- 1 member for the term of four years
- 1 member for the term of five years

As the terms of members of said Board expire, their successors shall be appointed for terms of five (5) years each. Vacancies in unexpired terms shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointments are made. The Board shall elect from its membership a Chairman, and a secretary and such other officers as it deems necessary to serve at its pleasure. The Board shall adopt rules and regulations covering procedures of the Board in the use of land, building, equipment and other facilities under its jurisdiction. Members of the Board shall serve without compensation. Said Board may employ a municipal director of recreation to be its executive officer. The Director, with the approval of the Board may employ such staff as may be necessary to carry out the recreational program determined by the Board. The salaries of a Director and his staff shall be fixed by the board. The tenure of a Director and staff shall be at the pleasure of the board. Traveling and other expenses of the Director and his staff in the performance of their duties shall be provided by the Board.

Be it further ordained by the Council that the recreation board shall be responsible for the direction, supervision, and promotion of such recreation programs as will contribute to the general welfare of the residents of the county or municipality, The board shall have control over all lands, buildings, equipment and other facilities assigned for recreational purposes to the board by the county or municipal governing body or purchased or leased by it from funds provided by the governing body. The Board shall cooperate with other local agencies and state and federal agencies for the purpose of maintaining and improving recreational services and facilities for the county or municipality. The Board shall have power to accept financial and other aid and grants from any public or private agency.

Be it further ordained that said Board shall have all power, rights and duties set out in Sections 274 through 279 of Section 12 of the 1940 Code of Alabama as Recompiled.

ORDINANCE NO. 26

Councilman W. W. Foster introduced the following Ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE TO CALL A REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILSONVILLE , ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: That the regular municipal election in the town of Wilsonville, Alabama, shall be held on the second Tuesday in August, 1968, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and five members of the Council, and a second or "run-off" election shall be held on the first Tuesday after the second Monday in September, 1968, if necessary. The municipal officers elected shall assume the duties of their respective offices on the first Monday in October following such election and shall serve for a term of four years.

Section Two: That the voting places of said election shall be at the following places within the Town of Wilsonville, Alabama: City Hall.

Section Three: That the Mayor and Clerk be and they are hereby directed to give notice of said election at least forty days prior to the date of holding the same or before the third Tuesday in June preceeding the election by giving notice in a newspaper published within the City or by posting notice in three public places within the city, as provided by law; the publication of this ordinance will be sufficient notice of the calling of said election.

Section Four: That any person desiring to become a candidate at such election may become such a candidate by filing in the office of the Mayor a statement of candidacy accompanied by affidavit taken or certified by any officer authorized to take acknowledgments in this State; that such person is duly qualified to hold the office for which he desires to become a candidate. Such statement shall be filed by 5:00 o'clock p.m. on the first Tuesday in July, 1968, and shall be substantially in the following form:

I, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am a citizen of the Town of Wilsonville, in said County, and reside in said Town; that I desire to become a Candidate for the office of \_\_\_\_\_ in said Town for the term of four years at the election for such office to be held on the second Tuesday in August, 1968, being August 13, 1968; that I am duly qualified to hold said office if elected thereto and I hereby request that my name be printed upon the official ballot at said election.
