

ORDINANCE NO. 30

Section 1. WHEREAS, the City of Wilsonville, ALABAMA has heretofore granted or may grant to certain Utilities the right to locate its Facilities upon, across, under, and along the Public Roads and Streets under the jurisdiction of said City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wilsonville, ALABAMA reserves the right to approve the place of location and the manner of locating utility Facilities on Public Roads and Streets under the jurisdiction of the City; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary for the City of Wilsonville, ALABAMA to adopt certain standards for accommodating utilities on Roads and Streets of the City which have or will involve the expenditure of State or Federal Highway Funds in order to qualify for any future State or Federal Aid Road and Street Benefits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that the (City Council)

(Board of Commissioners) of the City of Wilsonville,

ALABAMA hereby formally adopts the State of Alabama Highway Department Standards for Accommodating Utilities on Highway Rights of Way as standards (as written and future amendments thereto) for use by the City for accommodating utilities on Roads and Streets under the jurisdiction of the City on those Roads and Streets which have or will involve the expenditure of State or Federal Highway Funds.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after the earliest date permitted by law, upon and after its final enactment and publication as required by law.

ADOPTED, This the 3rd day of January 1972

Said Ordinance was read at length, and thereupon, Councilman D. F. Bolton moved that unanimous consent of the Mayor and Council be given for the immediate consideration of and action upon said ordinance, which motion was seconded by Charles Dillard. Said motion for unanimous consent was submitted to a vote of the Council and said vote resulted as follows:
