

Section 6. Ratification and Confirmation. The Franchise Ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 7. Publication and Delivery. The Council hereby directs the Town Clerk to publish this ordinance in accordance with the laws of Alabama by causing it to be posted in three public places within the municipality, one of which shall be at the post office or the Mayor's office in said Town. The Council also directs the Town Clerk to deliver a certified copy of this ordinance to Masada Communications, Inc. as evidence of the Council's approval of Masada Telecommunication, Inc.'s transfer of franchise rights.

ORDINANCE # 67

An Ordinance to adopt a standard code relating to fire prevention.

Whereas it is the desire of the Town Council of the Town of Wilsonville to adopt various Standard Codes set forth by the State of Alabama relating to fire hazards and fire prevention:

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Wilsonville, that the following codes are hereby adopted:

501.1.2 No person shall kindle or maintain any bonfire or rubbish fire or authorize any such fire to be kindled or maintained on any private land unless (1) the location is not less than 50 ft. from any structure and adequate provision is made to prevent fire from spreading within 50 ft. of any structure, or (2) the fire is contained in an approved waste burner located safely not less than 15 ft. from any structure.

501.1.3 Bonfires and rubbish fire shall be constantly attended by a competent person until such fire is extinguished. Such person shall have a garden hose connected to the water supply, or other fire extinguishing equipment readily available for use.

501.1.4 The Fire Official (Chief) may prohibit any or all bonfire and outdoor rubbish fires when atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make such fires hazardous.

Be It Further Ordained that within said Codes when reference is made to the duties of certain officials named therein that designated official in the Town of Wilsonville, who has duties corresponding to those of the named official insaid Code shall be deemed to be the responsible official in so far as enforcing the provisions of said Code are concerned.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED THAT this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after it's passage, the public welfare requiring it.
