ORDINANCE # 95-0905

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE NAMING OF STREETS WITHIN THE TOWN OF WILSONVILLE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS THE WILSONVILLE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILSONVILLE will be following the criteria set forth be E911 for the naming of CITY STREETS.

No street will be named unless there are three (3) or more residence residing on an unnamed street.

The Town of Wilsonville will be responsible for the buying of signs, posts and the insatllation of same.

Should a STREET be named not following this criteria; it will not be recognized by the E911 system.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by adoption by the Town Council of the Town of Wilsonville, Alabama.
