

The Wilsonville Town Council met in regular session, Monday, November 02, 2009, in the Council Chamber Room at the Wilsonville Town Hall. Mayor Rosemary Liveoak called the meeting to order at 6:30 P. M.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Councilman Calvin Gill.

The following council members answered roll call: Dennis Blackerby, Calvin Gill, Patricia Johnson, Lee McCarty, Terry Newman, Alan Revis, Melissa Rosetta.

The minutes of the October 05, 2009, regular council meeting, which had been mailed to the council members prior to the meeting, were reviewed. Alan Revis made a motion to accept the minutes as presented; Calvin Gill seconded. The motion passed with the following vote: Dennis Blackerby, yes; Calvin Gill, yes; Patricia Johnson, yes; Lee McCarty, yes; Terry Newman, yes; Alan Revis, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes; Rosemary Liveoak, yes.

The financial reports (mailed to the council members before the meeting) were reviewed. Terry Newman made a motion to accept the financial reports, as presented. Melissa Rosetta seconded, and the motion passed with the following vote: Dennis Blackerby, yes; Calvin Gill, yes; Patricia Johnson, yes; Lee McCarty, yes; Terry Newman, yes; Alan Revis, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes; Rosemary Liveoak, yes.

Harry Chandler, representative of SouthWest Water Company, who presented the report on the recent smoke testing of the sewer system at the Work Session Meeting immediately preceding the council meeting, addressed the council. He stated the next step in the sewer rehabilitation project is to video the lines. Mr. Jacobs has submitted a price of between \$25,000.00 and \$26,000.00 to do this work, and he can do repairs as he is videoing. The question was raised concerning the point of repair—at the right-of-way or at the customer tap. Mr. Chandler recommended at the customer tap which is already in the town's ordinance. He also stated the need for a new chemical feed pump and chemicals (cost of approximately \$1,000.00 per drum) at the plant. Terry Newman made a motion to hire Mr. Jacobs to perform the video and repair work on the sewer line and to authorize SouthWest Water to install the pump and acquire the necessary chemicals for the testing at the plant. Calvin Gill seconded. The motion passed with the following vote: Dennis Blackerby, yes; Calvin Gill, yes; Patricia Johnson, yes; Lee McCarty, yes; Terry Newman, yes; Alan Revis, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes; Rosemary Liveoak, yes.

Ordinance Number 090908 concerning water services was discussed. It was suggested the application for service and customer regulations be referenced in the ordinance. Mayor Liveoak also stated she would like to add a provision for master-metering all manufactured home parks. Melissa Rosetta made a motion to table the ordinance until the December meeting; Dennis Blackerby seconded. The motion passed with the following vote: Dennis Blackerby, yes; Calvin Gill, yes; Patricia Johnson, yes; Lee McCarty, yes; Terry Newman, yes; Alan Revis, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes; Rosemary Liveoak, yes.

Dennis Blackerby discussed the Town Firearms Ordinance 93-004 and Ordinance 071105-1, both of which are confusing and difficult to enforce. He had copies of the regulations from Calera and Chelsea, as well. He suggested we simply enforce the state regulation. Lee McCarty made a motion to rescind Ordinances 93-004 and 071105-1, enforce the state regulation and post the state regulation on the Town website. Patricia Johnson seconded the motion. The motion will be voted on at the December meeting since it involves changes to ordinances.

The Town Clerk read acknowledgements of thanks from ClasTran and South Shelby Chamber of Commerce for the recent donations made to those entities.

Mayor Liveoak requested authority to have counters added to the clerk's windows and ten feet of cabinets built in the town clerk's office for storage. She has gotten a price of **\$2,750.00** from D B & J Cabinet Shop. Dennis Blackerby made a motion to authorize the work; Melissa Rosetta seconded. The motion passed with the following vote: Dennis Blackerby, yes; Calvin Gill, yes; Patricia Johnson, yes; Lee McCarty, yes; Terry Newman, yes; Alan Revis, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes; Rosemary Liveoak, yes.

Public Comment.

Don Davis stated the smoke test was done when it was too wet to be accurate, the worst of conditions. Councilman Blackerby stated he had expressed the same concern but was told by the engineer they are the experts.

Mayor Liveoak reminded everyone of the public meeting for the presentation of the comprehensive plan for Wilsonville, Thursday, November 05, 2009, 6:30 P. M., Wilsonville Elementary School Cafetorium.

Melissa Rosetta reminded everyone of the Civitan Club all-you-can-eat pancake supper and elementary school art show, Thursday, November 19, 2009, Wilsonville Methodist Church Life Center. All proceeds will go the Wilsonville Elementary School.

There being no further business to come before the council, Calvin Gill made a motion to adjourn. Dennis Blackerby seconded, and the motion passed with the following vote: Dennis Blackerby, yes; Calvin Gill, yes; Patricia Johnson, yes; Lee McCarty, yes; Terry Newman, yes; Alan Revis, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes; Rosemary Liveoak, yes.
