

The Wilsonville Town Council met Monday, August 2, 2010, in the Council Chamber, Wilsonville Town Hall. Mayor Rosemary Liveoak called the meeting to order at 6:30 P. M.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Councilwoman Melissa Rosetta.

The following council members answered roll call: Dennis Blackerby, Calvin Gill, Patricia Johnson, Lee McCarty, Alan Revis, Melissa Rosetta. Terry Newman was not present.

The minutes of the July 12, 2010, meeting (mailed to the council members prior to the meeting) were reviewed. Calvin Gill made a motion to accept the minutes as presented; Melissa Rosetta seconded. The motion passed with the following vote: Dennis Blackerby, abstain; Calvin Gill, yes; Patricia Johnson, yes; Lee McCarty, yes; Alan Revis, abstain; Melissa Rosetta, yes; Rosemary Liveoak, yes.

The financial reports, mailed to the council members before the meeting, were reviewed. Calvin Gill made a motion to accept the financial reports as presented; Alan Revis seconded. The motion passed with the following vote: Dennis Blackerby, yes; Calvin Gill, yes; Patricia Johnson, yes; Lee McCarty, no; Alan Revis, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes; Rosemary Liveoak, yes.

The mayor recommended the cemetery budget be amended to reflect the \$2, 225.00 cost of surveying the property in order to get the title to the entire property in the city's name and to move that amount from general fund to cemetery.

Patricia Johnson made a motion to amend the cemetery budget to reflect the \$2, 225.00 cost. Melissa Rosetta seconded the motion which passed with the following vote: Dennis Blackerby, yes; Calvin Gill, yes; Patricia Johnson, yes; Lee McCarty, yes; Alan Revis, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes; Rosemary Liveoak, yes.

Alan Revis made a motion to transfer \$2, 225.00 from general fund to cemetery and to amend the budgets accordingly. Melissa Rosetta seconded. The motion passed with the following vote: Dennis Blackerby, yes; Calvin Gill, yes; Patricia Johnson, yes; Lee McCarty, yes; Alan Revis, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes; Rosemary Liveoak, yes.

Mayor Liveoak reported the sewer fund needs money transferred to complete the fiscal year. There is money already in the budget to be transferred, which was put there for the sewer renovation project. There has been added expense for mapping for the grant application as well as extra repairs this year and more expense for supplies. Melissa Rosetta made a motion to transfer \$20,000.00 from the general fund to the sewer fund. Calvin Gill seconded. The motion passed with the following vote: Dennis Blackerby, yes; Calvin Gill, yes; Patricia Johnson, yes; Lee McCarty, yes; Alan Revis, yes; Melissa Rosetta Rosetta, yes; Rosemary Liveoak, yes.

Mayor Liveoak recommended the council meet Tuesday, September 7, 2010, for the regular meeting since the first Monday is Labor Day. Patricia Johnson made a motion to schedule the regular council meeting for September on Tuesday, September 7, 2010. Alan Revis seconded, and the motion passed with the following vote: Dennis Blackerby, yes; Calvin Gill, yes; Patricia Johnson, yes; Lee McCarty, yes; Alan Revis, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes; Rosemary Liveoak, yes.

The mayor reminded everyone of the August 23, 2010, budget work session meeting, at 6:00 P. M. A light supper will be served.

Public Comment

Melissa Rosetta asked about the survey of sewer customers for the grant application. Seventy-seven per cent of the customers fell in the low to moderate income category which should help in obtaining the grant. Mayor Liveoak delivered the grant application to Montgomery this morning.

Lee McCarty pointed out a Wilsonville resident was pictured in the current issue of bmetro Magazine. Dr. Karen Saenz was featured in an Excellence in Nursing section of the magazine. Dr. Saenz is Mr. McCarty's wife. He also stated there was a Nurses Association meeting, written up in the Birmingham News, held at his Wilsonville farm.

There being no further business to come before the council, Calvin Gill made a motion to adjourn. Patricia Johnson seconded; the motion passed with the following vote: Dennis Blackerby, yes; Calvin Gill, yes; Patricia Johnson, yes; Lee McCarty, yes; Alan Revis, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes; Rosemray, yes. The meeting was adjourned at 6:43 P. M.
